



Conditions of Sale

Venue

Foveran Deer Park sales complex, Foveran Deer Park, Haka Valley, Kurow, North Otago, 8km from Kurow (will be signposted).

Deer Inspection

Deer may be inspected in the paddock at any time prior to the sale by arrangement. On DAY OF SALE deer may be inspected from 11.30am.

DNA Identification

All Foveran master sires and our entire stud female breeding herd have now been DNA profiled (for confidence in the accuracy as to our breeding).

Insurance

Insurance facilities are available at the office. Insurance is the responsibility of the purchaser and any stock left on Foveran is strictly at the purchaser's risk.

Conditions of Sale

The sale will be conducted by PGG Wrightson with the conditions of sale as set down by the New Zealand Stock and Stations Agents Association, a copy of which is exhibited in the office on sale day.

Each lot becomes the purchaser's property and risk at the fall of the hammer.

Warranties and insurance are covered under separate headings.

Terms are strictly cash unless prior arrangements are made with the auctioneers. Accounts not paid within 14 days of sale shall bear interest, at 24% per annum from the date of sale.

If payment is not received within 30 days from sale, reservation of title will revert to Foveran for security purposes until account is paid in full, including interest owing.

The sale is conducted exclusive of GST.

A buyer's commission of 5% is payable to nonparticipating companies and recognised independent agents introducing and accompanying purchasers to the sale providing prior arrangements [no later than 24hrs prior to sale] are made with PGG Wrightson.

Intending purchasers are required to register with the auctioneers prior to the commencement of the sale.

Conditions of Sale cont./ Guarantee

No animals, embryos or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park or their germplasm or any subsequent progeny or germplasm, including the semen and germplasm of that progeny, may be supplied to a third party without the written permission of Foveran Deer Park.

This condition does not affect normal commercial deer farming or stud farming or the normal sales of semen or embryos as it only applies to entities with the primary function of commercial semen/germplasm activities.

It is a condition of sale of any animals, embryos, germplasm or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park that the purchaser agrees to include the following clause as a condition of any subsequent sale or gift of any animal, embryo, semen, germplasm or subsequent progeny or germplasm to a third party—"the purchaser acknowledges that it will not supply any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm to any commercial semen/germplasm marketing or sales entity, and will ensure that this clause is inserted as a condition of any sale or gift of any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm."

Our herd status continues to be a C10 classification.

Johnes tested

All stags in the sale have been Johnes tested clear.

Guarantee

All sale stags are guaranteed in terms of their genetic performance and temperament through DNA profiling. This does not include sickness or injury. All deer in this sale are tested for Johnes and are deemed sound for use as a sire stag. Any stag that does not meet the standards mentioned above will be replaced or a full credit given to use at a subsequent Foveran Deer Park Sale.

Number of antler points – owing to the lateness of stags this year at the time of selection, we have estimated the number of points we expect to see at the time of sale. Please note these are estimates only and we give no guarantee as to the actual number of points on sale day.

Mission Statement

Our motto Breeding the difference

a term that best describes our intention for our deer stud at Foveran.

By continuing our intensive breeding programme in what we believe is the largest red deer stud in New Zealand, it is our intention to supply the NZ deer industry with the very best genetics for venison growth rates, velvet production, and also our fast growing high end trophy antler stags.

- **DBVs** Venison growth rates. We continue to develop this major trait within our deer herd, with encouraging results. Our German herd for example, with Master sires such as Amadeus, Bonn, Wredeson Major & Red Baron leading the way, and some of our weaners at weaning in February topping out at 90kg. Yearling spikers to 155kg and 2 year olds to 253kg.
- **Velvet** By identifying specific lines of deer for velvet production, we are constantly improving the performance per animal to improve not only the production levels per animal but also the components of velvet conformation. As a result our velvet herd continues to grow with fast improving results.
- Trophy The fastest growing component of our deer industry at present. Foveran's commitment is to supply for ourselves high end trophies, but also to supply elite trophy genetics to the deer farming community. The continued improvement of our trophy herd is rewarding us with some massive red deer trophy antler heads with long tined heavy wide "wow" type configurations. Our German herd strategically crossed with European and English genetics has given us the opportunity to do that.

Temperament We continually manage and evaluate the herd for this important trait.



COMMENT: Purchased from Malcolm Cane for the top price of \$62,000, McCaw is an outstanding addition to our master sire line up. Placed 2nd in the Rising Stars 3yr HA Competition and also voted People's Choice in that competition. Malcolm considered retaining him for a sire. He is a great all round stag with superb temperament, great body confirmation and incredible antlers! Bifurcating brow, beys and treys with super heavy tops. His dam is a full sister to Kane. We consider these genetics to be very high in the ranking with the best head we have ever seen for a 3yr old. Odysseus has shown his genetic consistency with a large number of impressive sons produced.

Also interesting to note that grand dam 1003's brother 'Little Rock' had an IOA score slightly ahead of Salvador at 2 years. Great grand dam 3068 is the mega dam at Pelorus Deer stud for trophy genetics. 5th in the 2009 Rising Stars HA competition, and with 2 other full brothers in the Top 5, this confirms the heritability we can expect from this rising star. Apollo is impressive this year with his best head yet.








Lot 1: Tag 4150 Pure European 2yr son of Alexander






Comment: This is the first Alexander 2yr old son to be offered for sale. His heavy beamed high scoring antler is being passed on to his progeny. Dam sire Morpheus was a national 3yr HA Champion. He is also the sire of Phobeter (609 IOA @ 4yrs). Note too the very heritable Chancellor Peel (sire of Odysseus, Salvador and Commander Peel to name a few) on the bottom line. This stag has very strong fronts, and a heavy beam. Expect multi tops, at least 20 points.




Comment: Gregor was the sire of our impressive spiker placed 2nd in the National 1yr HA competition in 2016. He was also the sire of lot 15 sold last year for \$45,000 and placed 3rd in the National 2yr HA Competition in 2016. Dam sire Huneric was a National 2yr HA Champion. You only have to look at past Rising Star competition results to see how many times he appears in the pedigree of the entrants to confirm his heritability. This stag has strong beys and treys and is long and wide. Expect over 20 points.



Comment: Gregor is the sire of our impressive spiker placed 2nd in the National 1yr HA Competition in 2016. He also sired lot 15 sold at last years sale for \$45,000 and placed 3rd in the National 2yr HA competition in 2016. He will be on display at the sale with his best head yet. A truly impressive and very heritable sire. Dam sire Apollo is looking fantastic this year. He is Lot 75 in this sale, with his best head yet. A full brother to Discombe (National 2yr HA Champion). Note too Salvador (dam sire of Lord haka) on the bottom line. This stag has a very strong antler with a heavy beam and big tops. Expect at least 30 points.



Comment: A full brother to Lot 1 showing the consistency of this pedigree. Alexander's heavy beamed high scoring antler over Morpheus, National 3yr HA champion. Note too the very heritable Chancellor Peel (sire of Salvador, Odysseus, Commander Peel and many other top industry sires) on the bottom line. This stag has a wide antler with droppers. We estimate 10 x 11 points.




Lot 5: Tag 4056 Pure European 2yr son of Faulty Towers



Comment: Faulty Towers at 558 IOA at just 4 years was impressive. The small offering of Faulty Towers sons in this catalogue confirm his heritability. Dam sire Odysseus is extremely heritable also. He is the sire of Mentor, McCaw, Houghton and many other industry sires. Kane on the bottom line is a full brother to Hector and the sire of one of our top trophy dams 6285. This stag has big fronts and a long beam. A very strong head. Expect multi tops but at time of writing it's too early to estimate points.

Lot 6: Tag 4096 Pure European 2yr son of Prince



Comment: Prince was sold at our 2013 stag sale as a 2yr old at 194kg cutting 11.7kg of antler for \$46,000. Dam sire Woody produced us some impressive 2yr old stags for that sale also. Most notably Lot 4, a 2yr old at 204kg cutting 9.56kg antler sold for \$17,000. Also lot 9 another 2yr old at 195kg cutting 10.07kg of antler, also sold for \$17,000. This stag has big multi pointed tops. Expect 13 x 13 points.



Lot 7: Tag 4097 Pure European 2yr son of Lord Haka




Comment: Lord Haka was sold by us as a 2yr old for \$52,000. He was impressive at that stage and continues to progress to 721 IOA at just 5 years. Dam sire Huneric is a very heritable sire.
