

## Conditions of Sale

#### Venue

Foveran Deer Park sales complex, Foveran Deer Park, Haka Valley, Kurow, North Otago, 8kms from Kurow (will be signposted).

### **Deer Inspection**

Deer may be inspected in the paddock at any time prior to the sale by arrangement. On DAY OF SALE deer may be inspected from 12pm.

### **DNA Identification**

All Foveran master sires and our entire stud female breeding herd have now been DNA profiled (for confidence in the accuracy as to our breeding). All stock sold are DNA guaranteed.

#### **Insurance**

Insurance facilities are available at the office. Insurance is the responsibility of the purchaser and any stock left on Foveran is strictly at the purchaser's risk.

#### **Vetted In-Calf Hinds**

All adult hinds have been ultrasound pregnancy tested using a real time ultrasound scanner. Only confirmed pregnant hinds have been included in the sale. All testing was carried out by Dr Noel Beatson.

#### **TB Status**

Our herd status continues to be a C10 classification.

#### Conditions of Sale

The sale will be conducted by Rural Livestock Ltd with the conditions of sale as set down by the New Zealand Stock and Stations Agents Association, a copy of which is exhibited in the office on sale day.

Each lot becomes the purchaser's property and risk at the fall of the hammer.

Warranties and insurance are covered under separate headings.



# Conditions of Sale cont./ Guarantee

Terms are strictly cash unless prior arrangements are made with the auctioneers. Accounts not paid within 14 days of sale shall bear interest, at current rate per annum from the date of sale.

The sale is conducted exclusive of GST.

A buyers commission of 5% is payable to nonparticipating companies and recognised independent agents introducing and accompanying purchasers to the sale providing prior arrangements [no later than 24hrs prior to sale] are made with Rural Livestock Ltd.

Intending purchasers are required to register with the auctioneers prior to the commencement of the sale.

No animals, embryos or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park or their germplasm or any subsequent progeny or germplasm, including the semen and germplasm of that progeny, may be supplied to a third party without the written permission of the respective stud.

This condition does not affect normal commercial deer farming or stud farming or the normal sales of semen or embryos as it only applies to entities with the primary function of commercial semen/germplasm activities.

It is a condition of sale of any animals, embryos, germplasm or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park that the purchaser agrees to include the following clause as a condition of any subsequent sale or gift of any animal, embryo, semen, germplasm or subsequent progeny or germplasm to a third party—"the purchaser acknowledges that it will not supply any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm to any commercial semen/germplasm marketing or sales entity, and will ensure that this clause is inserted as a condition of any sale or gift of any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm."



### **Foreword**

#### **Dear Clients and Friends,**

Welcome to our 36th Annual Elite Hind and Weaner sale. Queens Birthday marked my 30th year at the stud this year and over that time it still amazes me to see the genetic gains made here at the stud and throughout the industry. I have been lucky enough to be away in Europe for May & June and took the opportunity to visit both Warnham Park and Woburn Abbey, hence why our sale is a little later this year.

Our breeding program this year again features high scoring stags for trophy production as that is what our core business has always been. We try and target combinations we feel have the potential to produce future World Record trophy stags.

However this year we have also included a number of sires which have well placed lower tynes as we do harvest velvet from the stags we produce. There are also some combinations that favour velvet genetics specifically as we recognise the value in the velvet production currently.

A highlight for the stud this year has been Cane's performance. He was placed 2nd in the National 4 year Rising Stars Competition. His antler scores a massive 751 IOA with burrs and spread added. We collected semen from him this year and used a batch fresh for AI which achieved over 80% pregnancy and so we are able to offer a number of matings in this sale.

Also don't miss the couple of hinds mated to Agnew, a full brother to Nixon who scores 592 IOA at just 3 yrs – 77 inches more at the same age!

All hinds have been scanned by Dr Noel Beatson. There are no back up matings in the sale and we have noted on each how they were mated and given the approximate birth dates where we can. From what we know, you can expect a reasonably early fawning which should ensure a good weaning weight for the progeny from these hinds.

As always, we welcome any feedback and look forward to hearing from you in this regard. We look forward to catching up with you at the sale and wish you well with your purchases.

# Mission Statement

#### Our motto

### **Breeding the difference**

a term that best describes our intention for our deer stud at Foveran.

By continuing our intensive breeding programme in what we believe is the largest red deer stud in New Zealand, it is our intention to supply the NZ deer industry with the very best genetics for venison growth rates, velvet production, and also our fast growing high end trophy antler stags.

#### DBVs

Venison growth rates. We continue to develop this major trait within our deer herd, with encouraging results. Our German herd for example, with Master sires such as Amadeus, Bonn, Wredeson Major & Red Baron leading the way, and some of our weaners at weaning in February topping out at 90kg. Yearling spikers to 155kg and 2 year olds to 253kg.

#### Velvet

By identifying specific lines of deer for velvet production, we are constantly improving the performance per animal to improve not only the production levels per animal but also the components of velvet conformation. As a result our velvet herd continues to grow with fast improving results.

### Trophy

The fastest growing component of our deer industry at present. Foveran's commitment is to supply for ourselves high end trophies, but also to supply elite trophy genetics to the deer farming community. The continued improvement of our trophy herd is rewarding us with some massive red deer trophy antler heads with long tined heavy wide "wow" type configurations. Our German herd strategically crossed with European and English genetics has given us the opportunity to do that.

Temperament We continually manage and evaluate the herd for this important trait.





**COMMENT:** Cane has been bred here at Foveran. A son of the very heritable McCaw who has produced us so many top stags in previous sales. At 504 5/8 IOA, Cane was placed 4th in the National 2yr HA Competition. As a 3yr old he was placed 3rd in the 3yr section. This year Cane was place 2nd in the 4yr section of the Rising Stars competition with 751 IOA. His mass of antler is impressive and we expect him to continue to improve with age.

**COMMENT:** Bred here at the stud, his sire Henry VIII has a sound reputation for leaving heavy beamed sons. Fitzroy's dam 9119 is a full sister to Prince Philip who was the SCI World Record sire for 2012. Her dam sire Lewis is also the sire of former SCI World Record sire Charlie Mac and Legend. With the sale of McCaw and Alexander this year and the introduction of new sires into the mob, Fitzroys antler growth was affected. We expect it to return to normal this coming season and so continue to use him in our breeding program.



**COMMENT:** Sired by Fig Jam who has been scored in excess of 800 IOA and with an antler structure typical of his breeding, Munro has an antler structure with the "wow" factor. His dam sire Discombe was a National 2yr HA Champ. He matured at 652 SCI with a 62 inch spread which looks to have been inherited by this young sire. Munro has recovered well as expected after damaging his antlers last year. He grew an impressive 619 IOA this year earning him a place in our breeding program.

### Lot 3: Pure Ardleigh McCaw Embryo Recip tag: 5051




**Comment:** Sire is Hudson's McCaw, a NZ velvet champion sire over Hudrocks heavy beamed antler. Both sires ideally suited for velvet production. Hudrock also has heavy multi pointed tops making him an excellent dual purpose sire. We would expect heavy beamed velvet with good tyne placement from this genetic combination.





**Comment:** Sire Hudrock is not only high scoring at 590 IOA at just 3 years but he also has a very heavy velvet head with nicely placed tynes. We expect these genetics to mix well with those of Adonis (sire of Warlord 16.36kg HA) and Brusnik (sire of Huneric & Nixon). We expect any male progeny from this mix to have good tyne placement for potential velvet production but to also have a residual value as a trophy later in life.


**Comment:** We have included Brusnis in our breeding program again this year as we believe his antler structure is what we are looking to produce in our trophy stags. He has great tyne placement in his lowers with a heavy beam making for a dual purpose sire. His fully grown out antler certainly has the wow factor. Dam sire Bandit will add to the trophy potential in the genetics. Remember too that Discombe has a well structured head of antler and all sires in the mix are high scoring.





**Comment:** Super star Cane is the sire of this embryo. He was placed 2nd in the National 4yr HA Competition this year with an outstanding 751 IOA at just 4yrs of age. An impressive young sire who we believe is well matched to Adidas. Note too top all round Amadeus in the bottom line. We expect high scoring progeny at maturity with the "wow" factor from this mix.


