



Venue

Foveran Deer Park sales complex, Foveran Deer Park, Haka Valley, Kurow, North Otago, 8km from Kurow (will be signposted).

Deer Inspection

Deer may be inspected in the paddock at any time prior to the sale by arrangement. On DAY OF SALE deer may be inspected from 12 noon.

DNA Identification

All Foveran master sires and our entire stud female breeding herd have now been DNA profiled (for confidence in the accuracy as to our breeding).

Insurance

Insurance facilities are available at the office. Insurance is the responsibility of the purchaser and any stock left on Foveran is strictly at the purchaser's risk.

Conditions of Sale

The sale will be conducted by PGG Wrightson with the conditions of sale as set down by the New Zealand Stock and Stations Agents Association, a copy of which is exhibited in the office on sale day.

Each lot becomes the purchaser's property and risk at the fall of the hammer.

Warranties and Insurance are covered under separate headings.

Terms are strictly cash unless prior arrangements are made with the auctioneers. Accounts not paid within 14 days of sale shall bear interest, at current rate per annum from the date of sale.

The sale is conducted exclusive of GST.

A buyers commission of 5% is payable to nonparticipating companies and recognised independent agents introducing and accompanying purchasers to the sale providing prior arrangements [no later than 24hrs prior to sale] are made with PGG Wrightson.

Intending purchasers are required to register with the auctioneers prior to the commencement of the sale.

All sale deer have been Johnes tested clear.

This condition does not affect normal commercial deer farming or stud farming or the normal sales of semen or embryos as it only applies to entities with the primary function of commercial semen/germplasm activities.

It is a condition of sale of any animals, embryos, germplasm or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park that the purchaser agrees to include the following clause as a condition of any subsequent sale or gift of any animal, embryo, semen, germplasm or subsequent progeny or germplasm to a third party—"the purchaser acknowledges that it will not supply any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm to any commercial semen/germplasm marketing or sales entity, and will ensure that this clause is inserted as a condition of any sale or gift of any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm."

All sale stags are guaranteed in terms of their genetic performance and temperament through DNA profiling. This does not include sickness or injury. All deer in this sale are tested for Johnes and are deemed sound for use as a sire stag. Any stag that does not meet the standards mentioned above will be replaced or a full credit given to use at a subsequent Foveran Deer Park Sale.

Mission Statement

Our motto Breeding the difference a term that best describes our intention for our deer stud at Foveran.

By continuing our intensive breeding programme in what we believe is the largest red deer stud in New Zealand, it is our intention to supply the NZ deer industry with the very best genetics for venison growth rates, velvet production, and also our fast growing high end trophy antler stags.

- **DBVs** Venison growth rates. We continue to develop this major trait within our deer herd, with encouraging results. Our German herd for example, with Master sires such as Amadeus, Bonn, Wredeson Major & Red Baron leading the way, and some of our weaners at weaning in February topping out at 90kg. Yearling spikers to 155kg and 2 year olds to 253kg.
- Velvet By identifying specific lines of deer for velvet production, we are constantly improving the performance per animal to improve not only the production levels per animal but also the components of velvet conformation. As a result our velvet herd continues to grow with fast improving results.
- **Trophy** The fastest growing component of our deer industry at present. Foveran's commitment is to supply for ourselves high end trophies, but also to supply elite trophy genetics to the deer farming community. The continued improvement of our trophy herd is rewarding us with some massive red deer trophy antler heads with long tined heavy wide "wow" type configurations. Our German herd strategically crossed with European and English genetics has given us the opportunity to do that.
- Temperament We continually manage and evaluate the herd for this important trait.

Background History Glaadt Park Herd

Our commitment to the deer industry started way back in the early 1980s with the introduction of an Elk herd. Alongside that we imported the famed Schulte Wrede herd from Glaadt Park, Germany. This herd was made up of the top bloodlines throughout Germany and concentrated on Glaadt Park.

The balance of the Glaadt Park herd was eventually purchased, and after farming them in England for a short time we then imported them into New Zealand. The herd was culled, dissected and managed for two main genetic traits—antler formation and body weight. Some of the earlier stag weights were enormous with stags in the 300-350kg range. Antler formation was similar to the style and conformation of their forebears.

Since the herd arrived in New Zealand performance has improved and with the same breed influences of Red Baron, Myson, Munich and Image, an accelerated effect is becoming prevalent. To date our top line weaner stags are topping 90+kg at the end of March and our weaner hinds at 83+kg at the same time. Antler performance is also showing through with 8-12kg Hard Horn heads at 2 years old becoming the norm.

One of our top preforming master sires Wredeson Major, a direct descendant from Wrede, is a perfect example of our genetic improvement. He weighed in at 303kg at 3 years with a 40 point, 10.2kg head at 405 SCI. That body weight would rate as one of the heaviest 3 year red deer weights anywhere in the world. The important point here though, is this stag has all three traits: record live weight, huge antler and superb temperament.

On top of that, the following year we produced "Amadeus", an amazing animal with the biggest antler structure for a 2 year old the world has ever seen, clocking in at an incredible SCI score of 427, bodyweight of 218kg and a record 10.43kg HA. They are certainly powerful and heritable genetics.

We expect with continual management using DNA and hind indexing, that this herd will continue to grow and show that this is an exceptional herd of deer.

Background History Warnham/Woburn Herds

The two main strains of English deer that make up our herd at Foveran are from Warnham and Woburn bloodlines.

The Warnham herd, owned by the Lucas family, has had a strong influence in the deer introduced into New Zealand. For instance the Poulter herd, introduced in the early 1900s at the Waimakariri, consistently grew big palmated multi-point heads and latterly introduced into New Zealand for farming in the late 1980s. They have proven themselves time and time again with record heads and velvet weights. An example would be William John, unquestionably one of the best Warnhams ever produced, with a record antler of 532 SCI at 5 years with 68.5" outside spread. And the following year he had a huge head of 19.2kg Hard Horn and 552 SCI est. On top of that is Mountbatten (Hercules x Duncan, Sire of Prince Philip), one of the most highly regarded Warnham stags in the country, and of course "Sovereign."

The Woburn Abbey herd has also influenced our subsequent deer herds around New Zealand with genetics such as Russell, Harvey, Kane, Hector, Bradford, Lord T and Berry End; and others too numerous to mention but equally important. Hector last year scored 623 SCI which firmly cements him as one of the leading trophy sires in the industry.

The crossing of the lines over traditional German and Eastern bases have left new antler records all over the country. The importance of these English introductions to our now famed German herds cements this. Their multi-point antlers are very heritable and show what a strong genetic strain of deer they are.







COMMENT: This guy has been our flagship for many years now, and still rates highly beside imports such as Red Baron and Myson. Wredeson's claim to fame is his high heritability factor. For example, Wredeson II and now Wredeson Major—the heaviest ever 2 year old Pure German at 243kg with a 34 point head of antler. Wredeson continues to impress with his own credentials and will carry on exhibiting his genetic traits in many generations to come with his progeny. He is now deceased, but has left a massive legacy in our herd and we will continue to use his genetic influence in our herd.







His massive multi point head of 535 IOA at just 5 years was awesome. He is used extensively over our Germans to enhance trophy genetics within our herd. His 57 point head remains impressive. This year he has developed hugely strong outrigger tines with the remainder of the antler structure intact and so we look forward with interest to see what happens next! An impressive Woburn sire.

COMMENT: Purchased from Stanfield Park for \$95,000. Sadly we lost Mountbatten during the rut two years ago. By a stroke of luck he served his donor hinds and so his legacy will continue in our herd for some time yet. He was a magnificent sire in his own right and one of the most heritable to date.

His heritable antler factor is second to none with many huge spiker and 2 year heads in our herd. Another 2 year son has an incredible antler weight of 11.86kg with 371 IOA score. A new record for antler weight for age, breaking the previous record by over 2.2kg. Also sire of our master sire Prince Philip.



We have some excellent sons—both Pure English and English German cross coming through with huge antler specs. One of his spikers has an enormous rack at 31 points with thick heavy mass. Another 2 year son features with Deer Genetics called JRDG, crossed with Adonis. A huge beautifully correct head of antler. His outside span is 68.5 inches and must also be close to a record in the industry. His huge mansion of antler has what we term the "wow" factor and this is becoming increasingly important in the trophy industry, a prerequisite for the discerning hunter.





Also interesting to note that grand dam 1003's brother 'Little Rock' had an IOA score slightly ahead of Salvador at 2 years. Great grand dam 3068 is the mega dam at Pelorus Deer stud for trophy genetics. 5th in the 2009 rising stars HA competition, and with 2 other full brothers in the Top 5, this confirms the heritability we can expect from this rising star.
